(Keep Caps & Lids On)

Bottles & Jars
(No Caps On)

Metal

Aluminum & Steel Cans
(Place Loose Metal Lids Inside Can)

Food & Beverage Cartons
(Keep Caps On)



DOES NOT GO IN RECYCLE BIN

DO NOT PUT THESE RECYCLING CONTAMINANTS IN YOUR HOME CART-BRING THEM TO A RECYCLING DROP-OFF LOCATION



NO BATTERIES

Batteries and small electronics with batteries can explode and start fires if crushed or punctured.



NO PLASTIC BAGS, PLASTIC WRAP, OR BLACK PLASTIC

These items become tangled on sorting equipment and have to be removed by hand.



NO STRING LIGHTS OR ELECTRICAL CORDS

These items get wrapped around sorting equipment and have to be removed by hand.



NO SHREDDED PAPER

Shredded paper is too small to be recycled at a facility-bags of shredded paper break open.



NO RANDOM METAL ITEMS

Recycling sorting facilities are only built to handle metal food and beverage containers.



NO STYROFOAM™ OR #6 PLASTIC

Recycling sorting facilities are only built to handle metal food and beverage containers.
